

# DRESSAGE TASMANIA YOUNG RIDER SQUAD INFORMATION



## Aim

Our aim is to assist young dressage riders to further their equestrian development enabling them to compete successfully at Official level in Dressage Tas competitions, with a view to providing a pathway to compete at Interstate and National YR Events.

Any young rider who is committed to becoming a better dressage rider and is competing (or is planning to) in Official Dressage Tasmania competitions is encouraged to apply.

## Conditions for Young Rider Squad Membership

### Rider

- Aged 10 to 21 (until the end of the year in which you turn 21) or from 8yrs if riding a pony.
- A current financial member of the Equestrian Tasmania (ET)
- A current financial member of Dressage Tasmania (DT)
- Aiming to compete in Official DT competitions (if not already doing so)
- Attend YR Squad Training Days
- To show good Horsemanship and Sportsmanship at all times
- To show respect to all Coaches, Officials, Parents and Riders at YR/DT events
