This Event will be held under current Equestrian Australia/FEI Eventing Rules 1<sup>st</sup> January 2017, and all subsequent corrections and modifications as published by the FEI and the EFA with their provisions taking precedence.

### *EA 507.6 Disclaimer of liability*

Neither the Organising Committee of any event to which these rules apply nor Equestrian Australia accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury, or illness to horses, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

### *EA 507.7 Reservation of right*

The organiser reserves the right:

- To cancel any class or event
- To divide any class
- To transfer competitors between sections of a class
- To alter the advertised times
- To refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason."

## **DRUGS AND SWABBING**

The Ground Jury may at any time order the testing of any horse in accordance with the articles of the FEI Veterinary Regulations.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

Riders please note that all qualifications listed as per Equestrian Australia rule book, must be fulfilled by the close of entries date.

School Riders must be familiar with the specific qualification requirements.

### *CNC\* (including Interschool 1star)*

Open to any EA member who from the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 14 and over, and riding a registered horse which turns 6 or more in the current calendar year. Both horse and rider must be qualified to compete in CNC\* or above - See Art 520.4 EA Eventing rules

### *EvA105 (INCLUDING INTERSCHOOL EvA105)*

Open to any EA member who from the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider reaches 13yrs and over, riding a registered horse turning 4 years or over from the beginning of the calendar year.

### *EvA95 (INCLUDING INTERSCHOOL EvA95)*

Open to any EA member who from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 8yrs and over (riders under the age of 13 must have completed an EvA80), riding a registered horse turning 4 years or over from the beginning of the calendar year.

### *EvA80 (INCLUDING INTERSCHOOL EvA80)*

Open to any EA participation or full member who from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 8yrs and over, riding a horse turning 4 years or over from the beginning of the calendar year.

### *EvA65 (INCLUDING INTERSCHOOL EvA65)*

To ride in Training and Learners, riders must be either TEA members (NTEC, STEA or NWEA) or EA members of at least Participation level. Note TEA membership only provides third party insurance and not the comprehensive cover of EA Membership.

## **PONY CLUB COMPETITION**

Open to any current member of PCAT. Please use Nominate to enter; entries are not via club DC's.

## **INTERSCHOOL CLASSES**

Equestrian Australia (Tasmanian Branch) Interschool Regional Championships Official Interschool classes are open to all riders who are current members of Equestrian Australia. Unofficial classes (EvA65) are open to TEA or EA members. The ODE classes are open to riders who are secondary school students. Please note this competition is NOT the State Championships for the school dressage, show jumping or show horse.

Please refer to membership and horse registration requirements above for each grade.

The ODE classes are open to Secondary school riders enrolled in year 7 to 12 inclusive in the year of competition, up to 18 years in the year of competition. Primary school riders may also enter the ODE classes up to and including EvA95 if eligible as per the EA eventing rules.

- Riders who qualify may be offered the opportunity to represent Tasmania at the Australian Interschool Championships in Toowoomba, September, 2017 provided they have met the standard required.
- The organising committee may reject an entry if it considers the Welfare of the horse may be at risk.
- Horses are only required to be Equestrian Australia registered for Interschool EvA95 class and above.
- School riders may also enter the respective EA class. Levies only need to be paid once. Therefore if eligible, a school rider could possibly enter the open class, the Interschool class and Combined Training by paying the entry fee for all 3 classes- they will only ride one dressage test, showjumping round and XC course, however they will be eligible for 3 prizes).

### **INTERSCHOOL COMBINED TRAINING**

Open to Primary School riders enrolled up to and including year/grade 6 in the year of competition; or Secondary school riders enrolled from year 7 - 12. The Combined Training competition is a dressage test and showjumping round. There is no cross country phase.

### **DRESS**

As per Equestrian Australia rule no. 538.

Interschool classes – formal school uniform. Please note that if entering both Interschool and open classes, riders should wear school uniform.

Pony Club classes – official Pony Club uniform.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

Warning - Stallions may be present at this Event.

Compulsory levies are charged to cover various fees including ambulance/medical, course and equipment fees.

Refunds will be made according to the Rule Book with appropriate Medical/Veterinary Certificates, less administration fee.

### **PRIZES**

*Eventing:*

Prizes in Equestrian Australia ODE classes will be awarded in accordance with current Equestrian Australia Rules for Official Horse Trials.

Prize money is dependent upon the number of starters.

Prize Money will be awarded in all Equestrian Australia ODE classes to:

3<sup>rd</sup> place

4<sup>th</sup> place if 10 or more starters

5<sup>th</sup> place if 15 or more starters

6<sup>th</sup> place if 20 or more starters

Ribbons will be presented in all classes.

Prize money will be announced in the Official Programme according to entries received. Entry fee includes a levy of \$10.00 per horse per class to cover ambulance/medical and veterinary costs..

*Interschool series:*

Place getters in the Interschool classes will be awarded with a ribbon to 4<sup>th</sup>.

### **CANTEEN**

A comprehensive canteen will be run during the event.

### **YARDS, CAMPING AND WASHBAY FACILITIES**

A considerable number of yards are available on a first come – first served basis for those not camping at the grounds. These MUST be cleaned out at the end of each use and all manure and hay placed in the collection points at the end of the yards.

Yards may be booked for those camping, to be via Nominate. Horses staying in the yards overnight are to be supervised by the rider/owners.

Camping is available at the TEC at a cost of \$10 per family per night camping, with limited access to power at the northern end of the yards in the car park, closest the clubrooms. A single shower exists within the toilet block. Camping is also to be booked via Nominate.

Two wash bays are available for use, please be considerate of water shortages in the area and use water wisely.
