## **HORSE SECTION REGULATIONS**

- A. This Show is an official Show affiliated with the Equestrian Australia (EA) & Show Horse Council of Tasmania Inc. (SHCT).
- B. Ring 1 Show Jumping classes are held under EA Rules.
- C. All horses competing in official saddle classes must be registered with the EA or SHCT with current revalidation of registration certificate, performance card, current height certificate, (for Saddle classes) and ridden by a current member.
- D. Performance cards must be carried for all Registered Horses. The relevant discipline card may be scrutinized upon entry into the ring or before the presentation of any prize. The performance card should be properly maintained. It is suggested that the card is periodically compared with the appropriate records.
- E. In Dorset District classes competitors must reside in the Municipality of Dorset permanently, or be a Financial Member of the North East Pony Club.
- F. Dorset Topsy competitors must be a resident of the Dorset Municipality and/or a member of a Pony Club.
- G. In this paragraph "Horse" in the definitions given below covers Small Pony, Large Pony, Galloway and Hack.
  - 1. Novice Horse: A horse which has won three Novice or one Open saddle class competing singly at an Official Show, with the exception of a consolation class, is not considered to be Novice.
- H. Competitors or owners may lodge a protest on any matter arising from the class in which the competitor's or owner's exhibit participated provided that:
  - 1. The protest is lodged in writing to the Secretary within one hour of the incident which is the subject of the protest.
  - 2. A deposit of \$20 is lodged with the protest. This deposit may be forfeited if the protest is judged by the Ground Committee that considers the protest to be frivolous.

- I. Stallions may not compete in Led/In Saddle Classes other than in those which are specified as Stallion classes.
- J. When shown, Stallions and Colts must wear a bridle and stallion bit and must be handled/ridden by a person 18 years & over.
- K. Exhibitors will be called in twice. No event will be held up for a competitor who is competing elsewhere.
- L. In classes where the age of the rider is specified, age will be taken as at the 1st day of the Show.

#### M. Code of Dress:

EA ruling on dress code must be strictly adhered to. All riders are requested to wear protective head dress and boots when riding on show ground, except where the traditional dress for their event precludes its use.

- N. When horses are not in the immediate care of their handler they are to be stabled or tied up in such a manner that they do not present a problem to themselves, other horses or the general public.
- O. All winners are required to parade at the completion of their respective classes.
- P. DOPING: It is forbidden to administer any stimulants, or depressant to a horse, or to cause one to be administered, in any way what so ever, either before the start of a competition or on the previous day, under the maximum penalty of disqualification for life of the owner, rider, horse and groom.(See FEI Rulings)

#### **Important Notice to all Exhibitors**

It is an offence to bring liquor onto the ground and to consume liquor in any area other than the designated section (near the shearing shed)
