





## COMPETITION AND HOUSE RULES



#### **NOTICES & UPDATES**

All riders to check the Noticeboard or event Facebook page for updates and important information. Notices will be published to both.

#### **ARRIVALS**

Gates open at 6.00 am.

Entry is from Equestrian Drive only and parking for horse floats permitted only on Acton Rd side of the yards.

Truck loading on the mound can be very disruptive to horses in the competition arena. Trucks using the mound to move horses are restricted to:

- Mornings no later than 1 hr before first class begins
- · Lunchtimes when no horses are competing
- Afternoons 1/2 hr after last horse finishes.

Water is available in the wash bays, at the front of the toilet block and from several taps throughout the yards.

#### **SPECTATORS**

Spectators are to keep to designated areas at all times. Maps will be displayed on site.

#### CHILDREN

Children under 10 are to be under adult supervision at all times for their safety and as a courtesy to competitors. Horses are unpredictable and DT accepts no responsibility for any accident or injury.

#### FIRST AID

First aid (human) is available at the site office.

#### DOGS

Dogs are not permitted on the grounds of the Tasmanian Equestrian Centre under any circumstances during this competition (Friday 1 - Sunday 3 March 2024). This includes in your car or float (or backpack!) - please leave Fido at home.

#### SCRATCHINGS

Notification of scratchings must be made by 5.00 pm the day prior to the Championships in writing. Refunds will not be paid unless an application in writing is made no more than 7 days after the event. This application must be accompanied by a veterinary/medical certificate, and forwarded to the Organising Committee (the administration fee is non refundable).

Note: A farrier's or chiropractor's certificate will not be accepted.

#### **EA RULES**

This event will be conducted in strict accordance with the EA Dressage Rules, effective January 2024, and FEI rules where the former do not apply, subject to any amendments or inclusions. Please take the time to familiarise yourself with the current rules. It is the responsibility of the rider to know the rules under which they compete. The 2024 EA Dressage rules can be found at the following link: www.equestrian.org.au and the FEI rules at www.fei.org.

Neither the Organising Committee of any competition to which these rules apply, or the EA, accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

All riders must have their horse's registration papers available for inspection if required.



#### COMPETITION AND HOUSE RULES



#### **BRIDLE NUMBERS**

Must be worn on BOTH sides of either bridle or saddle blanket in both warm-up and competition. Bridle numbers must be worn on halters when horses are yarded, hand-grazing or tied to the float. PLEASE check your draw bridle number before competition day!

#### LUNGING

Lunging is only permitted in the round yard and not in the fenced Pony Club area.

#### **GROUND FAMILIARISATION**

An EA Steward will be present at all times during ground familiarisation sessions and EA rules apply. Bridle numbers must be worn during familiarisation.

#### Friday 1st March:

- All arenas are available on Friday 1st March between 1.00pm and 4.00 pm only.
- Harrowing will commence at 4.00 pm.
- Arenas are NOT to be ridden on under any circumstances after this time.

#### Saturday 2nd March:

• Ground familiarization outside of arenas only is from 7:00 to 8:00 am.

#### Sunday 3rd March:

• Ground familiarization outside of arenas only is from 7.00 am to 8.00 am.

Please note rule 3.12. 24 hours prior to the event starting, a horse may only be ridden on the competition grounds by its nominated rider. However a groom wearing a prescribed safety helmet and boots may walk the horse, on a long rein only. This rule applies from the time of entering the ground on Friday.

#### **COMPETITION ARENAS**

There will be no admittance to the areas directly surrounding the competition arenas after 8.00 am Saturday and Sunday.

Riders should use the designated warm up areas and only enter the competition arena area immediately prior to their set competition time. Entering the area before your time will result in elimination. Riders should be aware that after the final test on

Saturday there will be no admittance to the competition arenas as they will be being prepared for Sunday's competition.

#### **WARM UP AREA**

Warmup areas are designated on page 17 of this program.

For safety reasons all foot traffic (includes spectators, grooms and coaches) must stay around the edges of the warm up area.

All horses to WALK only between the yards and the warm up area.

#### COACHES

All coaching to be conducted from the edges of the warm up area – headsets are encouraged to be used, but if unavailable then ensure any coaching does not disturb the judges.

#### RIDERS PLEASE BE AWARE:

All tests will start within the arena. Please refer to rule 3.7d of the National dressage rules found here:

https://www.equestrian.org.au/Dressage-rules Please ensure you are familiar with this rule and the process of starting a test within the arena.

### **COMPETITION AND HOUSE RULES**



#### **PRESENTATIONS**

As a courtesy to sponsors, organisers and others, all place-getters are strongly recommended to be in attendance at the presentations. Place-getters not in attendance may, at the discretion of the Organising Committee, forfeit any entitlement to prizes/prizemoney.

Competition attire is required of riders at presentations.

If you win a prize, please be sure to contact our sponsors and thank them for their support.

#### **CALCULATION OF CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES**

The following rules apply to the judging of Championships as in the 2024 EA Dressage Rules, Rule 8.9 and further referenced in Annex I.

- Championships are to be decided on a points system.
- All competing horses will be ranked on the combined results of tests at each level.
- The first-placed horse will receive 35 points, second will receive 34 points, third will receive 33 points and so on to the last placed horse.
- Where there are equal places, the Champion will be the horse with the highest aggregate percentage at that level. In the event of a further tie, the horse with the highest percentage in the higher competition at that level will be declared Champion.





## THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

- The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.
- At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, retirement and euthanasia. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.


