### **Competitor Information**



The Derby Day Competition offers five height classes, over a course which includes both show jumping and cross country style obstacles, with riders judged on time and jumping faults.

The Top Dollar Top Score Competition consists of riders selecting which show jump obstacles they complete, with each obstacle being worth points, the winner being the rider who accrues the most points in the allowed time.

### **Venue: Ouercus Park**

- Quercus Park is on Oaks Rd, Carrick. This venue is made available by Rural Youth Tasmania, please leave the grounds in perfect condition, we are very thankful for the use of the site.
- Entry will be via the NORTH GATE (second gate from highway).
- Please take home all your hay and manure, grass seed is available on the NTEC show jump trailer if your horse has dug up around your float.

#### Canteen – TBA

**Toilets** are the grey brick building north west to the arena.

Water please bring your own water.

Yards are available behind the sand dressage arena. Yards are to be left clean.

**Overnight camping** is available by pre-arrangement. Please contact Rebecca Evans 0407 736 007 to book. An overnight yard fee of \$5 applies.

**Warm up areas** – A large warm up area is located in the 'back car park' past the dog/SJ arena. A smaller area is available alongside the dog/SJ arena for rider's next due to compete. Please do not ride on the sand dressage arena.

**Dress** – Competition dress and presentation preferred. Neat attire also permitted.
