COMPETITION AND HOUSE RULES

- Gates open at 7.00 am Saturday and 6.00 am Sunday
- · Parking for horse floats permitted only in areas indicated on map.
- · Please take all rubbish with you.
- Please clean up after your horse this means all hay and manure. Remember to leave yards clean if you use them.
- · Horses must be tied up in yards.
- Please bring water for your horse. None is available at the grounds .
- · Lunging is only permitted in the designated area.
- · Spectators are to keep to designated areas at all times.
- Children under 10 are to be under adult supervision at all times for safety and as a courtesy to other competitiors.
- Please be mindful that horses are unpredictable and Dressage Tasmania accepts no responsibility for any accident or injury.
- Dogs are not permitted on the Thirlstane grounds under any circumstances.

- · First aid is available at the site office.
- · Random swabbing will take place.
- The Organising Committee, Dressage Tasmania, Equestrian Tasmania, accept no responsibility for damage, injury or loss to persons, animals or property as a result of the conduct of the event.
- Truck loading can be very disruptive to horses in the competition arena. As such, trucks using the mound to move horses are restricted to:
 - Mornings no later than 1/2 hr before first class begins
 - Lunchtimes when no horses are competing
 - Afternoons 1/2 hr after last horse finishes
- · Instructors in the warm up area must use headsets or will be asked to leave the area.
- All riders to check the Noticeboard for updates and important information.
- All riders must have their horse's registration papers available for inspection if required.
- Horses must wear ID numbers at all times including when in yards and when hand grazing.
- Please be mindful and watch your belongings.
 If you don't lock your vehicle, please lock your valuables in your glove box, or keep them with you.

HOUSEKEEPING CONT:

- OPENING TIMES: Grounds open 7am Saturday and 6am Sunday
- WATER: limited water is available, remember to bring water for your horse to drink.

Water will be available to wash or cool horses.

- · PARKING: Parking will be at the direction of the marshalls
- · FAMILIARISATION: Friday familiarisation 2pm 5pm,

Saturday familiarisation 8-8.30;

Sunday familiarisation 7-7.30

- FREESTYLE SOUNDCHECK: freestyle sound check 3-4pm Friday
- NO ADMITTANCE: There will be no admittance to the areas directly surrounding the Competition Arenas after 8.45 am Saturday, and 7.45 am Sunday.
- MANURE: All poo is to be cleaned up from your float/yard area and placed in the trailer provided. We also ask that if your horse does poo in the warm up that you clean this up or let the marshal know.
- · HAY: All hay is to be cleaned up and taken home
- HOLES: Any holes dug are to be filled in and the day co-ordinator notified
- DAMAGE: It is the rider's responsibility to let the day Co-Ordinator know if any damage has been caused by horse or a member of their party.
- FLIES: There are lots of flies, so I cannot stress enough that you need fly sprays (a few different types)
- · SPEED LIMIT: Speed limit is 5km/hr along the golf course road.
- PARKING: Parking will be by attendants. This will be in an L shape from the old yards to the boundary fence. The second row is NOT to be started until the first row is full.
- · CATERING: Food and Drinks available to purchase both days.
- IDENTIFICATION: Numbers are to be worn on both sides of your horse at all times while at the venue
- PRESENTATIONS: Presentation will not be mounted but riders are required to be in full competition attire and must be in attendance.
- · KNOW THE RULES: Onus is on the rider to know all current EA Dressage rules.

EA RULES

This event will be conducted in strict accordance with the EA Dressage Rules, effective January 2019, and FEI rules where the former do not apply, subject to any amendments or inclusions. We advise you to please take the time to familiarise yourself with the current rules.

Please refer to EA National Dressage Rule Book for further clarification. This is available for download at: www.equestrian.org.au/dressage-rules.

COMPETING

 It is recommended that competitors report to the Gear Steward for inspection 20 minutes prior to competing in each test.

Failure to complete a gear check **prior** to a test will result in elimination.

After your gear check and before your test you are not permitted to change any of your gear or dismount. If you do need to change anything you must re-present to the gear check again.

- Riders must present to Judges with identification numbers clearly visible. Riders are not required to stop and report to the Judge but should simply ride past the Judge so that they can clearly see the rider's number.
- Tests may not be commanded. Riders are not permitted to talk (to their horse or spectators) at all times while in the arena.
- · Please follow the directions of officials at all times.

PRESENTATIONS

- As a courtesy to sponsors, organisers and others, all place getters are strongly recommended to be in attendance at the Presentations. Place getters not in attendance may, at the discretion of the Organising Committee, forfeit any entitlement to prizes/ prize money.
- Competition attire is required of riders at presentations.

SCRATCHINGS

 Scratchings must be notified by 5.00 pm the day prior to the Championships. Refunds will not be paid unless an application in writing is made not more than 7 days after the event.

This application must be accompanied by a Veterinary/Medical Certificate, and forwarded to the Organising Committee (the administration fee is non-refundable).

Note: A farrier's or chiropracter's certificate will not be accepted.

GROUND FAMILIARISATION

All Arenas are available on Friday 28 Feb from 2pm until 5 pm. Raking will commence at approximately 5 pm. Please respect the groundsperson's wishes. Arenas are NOT to be ridden on under any circumstances after this time. Riders can only ride in arena surround and warm up area after that time, until 5 pm.

Saturday - Ground familiarization outside of the Arenas only is from 8-8.30 am.

Sunday - Ground familiarization outside of Arenas only is from 7.00 am - 7.30 am.

- · Freestyle sound check Friday afternoon.
- Please refer to change in rule 3.12. 24 hours prior to the event starting, a horse may only be ridden by its nominated rider on the competition grounds. However a groom wearing a prescribed safety helmet and boots may walk the horse on a long rein only.
- Competition rules apply from the time of entering the ground on Friday.

COMPETITION ARENAS

 There will be no admittance to the areas directly surrounding the Competition Arenas after 7.45 am Saturday, and 8.15 am Sunday. Riders should use the designated warm up areas and only enter the competition Arena area prior to their set competition time. Entering the area before your time will result in elimination.

Riders should be aware that after the final test on Saturday there will be no admittance to the Competition Arenas as they will be being prepared for Sunday's competition. Please use the warm-up areas only.

CALCULATION OF CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

The following rules apply to the judging of Championships as in the 2019 EA Dressage Rules, Rule 8.9 and further referenced in Annex I.

- Championships are to be decided on a points system.
- All competing horses will be ranked on the combined results of tests at each level.
- The first placed horse will receive 35 points, second will receive 34 points, third will receive 33 points and so on to the last placed horse.
- Where there are equal places, the Champion will be the horse with the highest aggregate percentage at that level. In the event of a further tie, the horse with the highest percentage in

- in the higher competition at that level will be deemed the Champion.
- · Young Rider ribbons are given for each class...

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

- 1. The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.
- 2. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- 3. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 4. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- 5. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, retirement and euthanasia.

The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.

EA GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT




- · Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others.

- Be aware of, and maintain an uncompromising adhesion to EA standards, rules, regulations and policies.
- Scrupulously avoid any conduct using privileged information to gain a personal or commercial advantage.
- Operate within the rules of the sport including national and international guidelines which govern Equestrian Sport, the member associations and the affiliated clubs.
- Do not use your involvement with EA, its member associations or affiliated clubs to promote your own beliefs, behaviours or practices where these are inconsistent with those of EA.
- Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with persons under the age of 18 years, as your words and actions are an example.
- Avoid unaccompanied and unobserved activities with persons under the age of 18 years, wherever possible.
- · Refrain from any form of harassment of others.
- Refrain from any behaviour that may bring EA, its member associations or affiliated clubs into disrepute.
- Provide a safe environment for the conduct of the activity.
- Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured.
- · Be a positive role model.
- Understand the repercussions if you breach, or are aware of any breaches of the EA Member Protection Policy.

MAP OF GROUNDS



HORSEWARE AUSTRALIA EQUESTRIAN TASMANIA CHAMPIONSHIPS AWARDS

CASA REAL Perpetual Trophy

Donated by Luiz Menezes in memory of his Andalusian stallion. The trophy is awarded to the best-performed warmblood based on the highest average percentage of the two best official tests ridden.

RAY WEBSTER Award

The trophy is awarded to the best-performed Tasmanian Young Rider based on the highest average percentage of the two best Official tests ridden. NOTE -Young Riders may enter an Official Competition from the start of the calendar year they turn 10 when riding horses, or 8 years of age when riding Ponies, and should be no older than 21 years of age at midnight on 31 December 2019.

MASTERS Perpetual Trophy

A trophy will be awarded to the rider 60 years of age or over on the first day of the event, based on the highest aggregate percentage of the two best official tests ridden.

TONERRE Perpetual Trophy

Donated by Barb Rowsell in memory of her GP Champion gelding "Tonnerre" This trophy is donated to the winner of the highest FEI Level test contested at the Tasmanian State Championships.

SCRUPLES LODGE THOROUGHBRED RACING STABLES Perpetual Trophy

This trophy is awarded to the Thoroughbred horse gaining the highest average percentage of all tests ridden over the Championships (minimum of two tests). Horses must be registered with the Australian Registrar of Racehorses.

RISING STAR PRELIMINARY PONY and RISING STAR NOVICE PONY TROPHIES

The Australian Sports Pony Registry have sponsored a special Golden Garland Rosette to be awarded to the winner of the Rising Star Preliminary Pony and the Rising Star Novice Pony. The winner of the Rising Star Preliminary or Novice Pony will be the highest placed eligible combination in the Preliminary or Novice Pony Championship.

WILHELM OF XANTHE Medium Tour Trophy

Donated by Karen Rycroft to celebrate the career of her champion gelding "Wilhelm of Xanthe". This trophy is donated to the winner of the Medium Tour at the Tasmanian State Championships.

SORELL REGIONAL SHOPPING CENTRE Perpetual Award

Awarded to the rider scoring the highest percentage of the Championships (not including Freestyle tests).

DUTCHBOY HIGH PERFORMANCE YOUNG RIDER Trophy

This trophy is awarded to the Young Rider scoring the highest percentage in an FEI test.

HORSEWARE AUSTRALIA EQUESTRIAN TASMANIA CHAMPIONSHIPS AWARDS

NORA O'SHEA Perpetual Trophy

This trophy is in memory of Nora O'Shea who was a great supporter of Dressage in Tasmania. The trophy is awarded to the highest percentage pony over the weekend.

SUSAN HENRY Perpetual Trophy

In honour of Susan Henry and her FEI horse "Ferrant", who were notable supporters of musical Dressage.

This trophy is awarded to the winner of the Small Tour Championship with the compulsory inclusion of a Freestyle Test.

TASRACING Off-the-Track Award - Official and Participant Championship

Presented to the previously raced TB horse gaining the highest % of all official tests ridden over the Official Championship (minimum two tests), and the horse with the highest % of all Participant tests. Horses must be registered with the Australian Registrar of Racehorses.

PAUL BROWN MEMORIAL TROPHY

Awarded to the Highest Scoring Baroque Horse competing over the Weekend - Horses must be registered with the relevant Baroque Society.

Tasmanian Medium Pony Champion

Donated by Larilla Riding Ponies.

Dressage Tasmania Small Tour Champion TrophyAwarded in memory of Shelagh Young

Sir Archibald Trophy Awarded to the overall young horse champion.

Donated by Lyn Bourn in recognition of Megan Daun's Tasmanian bred, owned and trained horse - who went from young horse to Grand Prix.




