An important message from Jamie Buckby, Equestrian Tasmania board member and State Eventing president:

As most of you know by now, Equestrian Australia has been placed into Voluntary Administration in the last two weeks. This was mainly due to the EA board feeling this was the only avenue left to them due to Sport & Recreation and some other Government monies being withdrawn and subsequently there was a possibility of becoming insolvent which would have had serious consequences.

I would like to make it clear that this does not affect Equestrian Tasmania or NTEC in any way at this point of time. The board of ETas is working hard to resolve any small issues that arise from this event and as far as we are concerned it is business as usual. 
