TEA Entry – Open to all TEA (NTEC/STEA/NWEA members), membership forms are included.

Riders competing in EVA 80cm and above also require an EA membership.

Canteen – A canteen will be provided.

Toilets - are available to the eastern side of the horse arena.

Water – Bring your own water.

Warm up areas – Large warm up area for all phases located in the ‘back car park’ past the dog/SJ arena. Smaller area available alongside the dog/SJ arena for rider’s next due to compete.

Dress – Competition dress and presentation preferred. Neat attire permitted for new members.

Ground pack up – Presentations will be held once the dressage arenas, XC course and show jump course have been packed away.
