Entry Conditions

- 1. Closing date of entries Friday, 2nd December, 2016
- 2. Horses may compete in up to two classes plus the Six Bar on Saturday. Horse may compete in up to two classes on Sunday.
- 3. Entries MUST have all horse, rider and owner details.
- 4. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by a completed commentary sheet for each rider and horse. No late entry accepted under any circumstance.
- 5. All current FEI and EA Rules will apply to competitors and horses. Competitions will be run under Equestrain Australia National Jumping Rules (September 2016) and EA General Regulations (Oct 2016). Dress code is formal as per Art. 246, 1.5. All owners and riders must be current members of Equestrian Australia for all classes in ring 1 (except the Six Bar) and classes 17 and 18 in ring 2. Horses entered in grading classes must be registered and produce current competition licence.
- 6. The Organising committee reserves the right at its absolute discretion to alter or amend any part of the program.
- 7. The Organising committee reserves the right to ballot horses if necessary.
- 8. Protests are to be submitted in writing to the Organising committee within 30 minutes of an incident or announcement of placegetters, with a fee of \$50, to be refunded if protest upheld.
- 9. Substitution of a nominated horse may take place ONLY at the discretion of the Organising committee.
- 10. Changing from nominated classes may take place ONLY at the discretion of the Organising committee.
- II Scratchings: 75% of entry fee will be refunded only if Veterinary or Doctors Certificate is produced up to three days after the competition.
- 12. Swabbing will take place.
- 13. An administration fee of \$20 per competitor must be paid with entries.
- 14. Yards will be available at \$10 per horse.
- 15. Juniors: Competitors may take part in competitions for juniors until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18. Young riders: competitors may take part in competitions for young riders from the beginning of the year they reach 16 until the end of the year they reach 21.
- 16. 2016 National Young Rider Series Tasmania Round 3: A rider may compete in this class on a maximum of 3 horses but points for National YR Series will only be allocated for 1 horse. The "points" horse must be nominated within 1 hour of the start of the competition and MUST be ridden prior to other horses entered and ridden by the same rider. 
