

BATTEN PARK

REGULATIONS

IT IS AN OFFENCE TO EXHIBIT DISEASED STOCK

1. Events commence at 8.30 am sharp, course will be open to walk at 8.00am. All classes are conducted under Equestrian Australia National Jumping Rules 2015. This program allows for graded and non graded events. Please make sure you are eligible for the events you are entering. For graded events all riders must be members of EA. and horses hold a current grading card. For non graded events please enter as per the rules of that class. Classes stating (A) and (B) will run together. Performance licence must be produced for prize money to be paid in graded events. Horse and rider must be present to receive their prize money and ribbon at the end of their class, or else prizes will be forfeited. EA approved helmets must be worn.

2. Riders may compete in graded events EA. regulation from the beginning of the calendar year from which they reach the age of 12 years.

3. All horses to be tethered securely with a head stall and rope or neck rope when unattended.

4. Riders are eligible for the Junior or Young Rider award in the Spring 1000 from the beginning of the calendar year from which they reach the age of 12 years until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 21 years.

5. Entries close on the 27th October 2015

The society reserves the right to limit horses to compete in only two classes.

HORSE SECTIONS

6. Protests will be dealt with by a special committee.

7. The Committee will give every possible facility to exhibitors and every care will be taken of exhibit, but no responsibility will be incurred by the Society.

8. The Society will not be responsible for any accident that might be caused through or by an exhibit, including the incorrect tethering or horses and this shall be a condition of entry onto the Batten Park Grounds.

9. The Committee reserves the right to combine or delete classes if necessary.

10. The Committee reserves the right to alter the grouping of a horses(s) in the jumping events if they see fit.

SECTION C - SHOWJUMPING

Judging will start at 8:30am sharp

Where classes have A and B sections, they will be run concurrently. Places are awarded in two divisions. Horses may compete in one division only. Riders in classes 6B and 7B must be under 18 years on show day.

Non Graded classes are open to both registered and non-registered riders and horses.

Graded classes are only for current EA "competitor" level members riding EA registered horses who hold a current competition license.
