CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

This Show is conducted under Royal National Agricultural and Pastoral Society rules and conditions and where necessary Equestrian Australia & Show Horse Council of Australasia Rules.

THE RNAPS ASKS COMPETITORS TO ASSIST IN MAKING SURE THAT ALL AREAS OF SAFETY ARE COVERED. YOUR CO-OPERATION IN THIS AREA WOULD BE GREATLY APPRECIATED.

- The RNAP Society reserves the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason.
- The RNAP Society reserves the right to alter the program or combine classes as it sees fit.
- It shall be the Competitor's/Exhibitor's responsibility to ensure the horse or rider is eligible and competes in the correct class.
- Where any exhibitor is found to be ineligible, it is the competitor's responsibility to withdraw from the class and will not be afforded a refund.
- Exhibitors entering horses do so entirely at their own risk, and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the Society, its Council Officers, Officials or Members in any respect whatsoever, other than the liability for refund of entry fees in the event of abandonment of any competition.

Exhibitors: MUST be a current financial member of EA or SHC Australasia

Saddle Horses: All Exhibits MUST be registered with EA or SHC Australasia. Registrations pending will not be accepted.

Riders: All riders MUST be a current financial member of EA or SHC Australasia. Memberships pending will not be accepted.

Measuring: Saddle Horse exhibits MUST have a CURRENT height certificate issued by EA TASMANIA or SHC TASMANIA, or be presented to the official measurer, to be measured on the morning of the show.

MEASURING TIMES WILL BE STRICTLY 8.00AM-9.00AM TUESDAY & 7.00AM TO 7.30AM WEDNESDAY.

Copy of current Height Certificate, Registration and Membership must be supplied with entries.

Suitable Attire: Riders must be suitably attired at all times while on the arena. Current ASA approved helmets must be worn at all times whilst mounted, unless specifically exempted for classes under EA or SHC Australasia rules. Long boots are not to be worn by riders under the age of 17.

Horse Control: Any horse which in the opinion of the Chief Steward is not under adequate control will be sent off the arena.

Scratchings: All scratchings prior to the show must be in writing and accompanied by a Veterinarian or Doctor's certificate. For scratching during the show PLEASE inform the arena office.

Protests: All protests must be lodged in writing with the Arena Office within 1 hour of the event to which the protest relates, accompanied by a \$100 cash deposit which is only refundable if the protest is upheld.

Payment of Prize Money: Prize Money will only be paid to Champion and Reserve Champion prize winners this year. Prize money may be substituted by product.

Swabbing: It is the intention of the Society that, all horses shall perform without the aid of any drug/s or prohibited/banned substance/s that affect the conduct, performance or appearance of the horse. Where the owner of a horse is under 18 yrs a Parent or Guardian shall be the Responsible Officer for presentation to be swabbed. **Random swabbing will take place.**

Animal Cruelty: Is forbidden at any time whatsoever whilst on any part of the showgrounds. Any person found guilty of an offence will be asked to leave the grounds immediately and reported to all Royal Show Societies, Equestrian Australia and Show Horse Council of Australasia. Refer to EA and SHC Australasia rules as appropriate.

Stabling: Straw will be provided by the Society for initial bedding only. Horse boxes must not be locked while occupied by an exhibit. They may be locked while the exhibit is out competing. Please make sure your stable is kept clean and the alleyways are clear at all times for the public. HORSES ARE NOT TO BE PREPARED IN THE ALLEYWAY. ALL PREPARATION IS TO TAKE PLACE IN THE STABLES. This has been identified as a risk management issue as the stable complex is open to the public at all times. Stables will be allotted subject to the Society's right to accept or reject any application and to cancel or re arrange allotment of any stables as may be necessary. **ALL manure to be picked up.**

All stables MUST be cleaned after use. Please use bins provided outside stable area.

SMOKING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN THE STABLE COMPLEX AT ALL TIMES.

Powered sites: A limited number of powered sites will be available at a cost of \$5 per night, per power outlet, no double adaptor or boards permitted. Power must be pre booked and paid with entries fees.

Parking: Parking is extremely limited. It is a condition of entry that you adhere to all instructions given by parking officials, which may include the requirement for you to unhitch your horse float from your vehicle.

Class Definitions:

Novice: Novices are exhibits or competitors, as is appropriate for the relevant class, who have not won a first place award at a Royal Show or a Royal National Show.

Age of Riders: Age of rider for all classes is to be of the day of competition.

Owner Rider Classes: Rider to be the registered owner of horse.

Childs Mount classes: To be ridden by child rider under 17yrs of age.

Sheila Bennett Good Hands: Competitors judged solely on riding ability with special attention paid to the hands and seat, and the general management and control of the mount. **Competitors must use an ordinary snaffle. Cavesson nosebands permitted only. Riders may not wear gloves or carry a whip or hacking cane.**

Mastermind Trophy: Open to all horses under 14.2hh. Horse to be ridden in a **snaffle bit**, by a rider 17 years and under on the 1st January in the year of the show. Horses compete for the Mastermind Perpetual Trophy (to be retained by the Show Society) with the winner each year receiving a memento.

Leading Rein: Leading Rein is open to Ponies n/e 12hh ridden by child 3yrs & under 8yrs. Riders in Leading Rein classes are ineligible to compete in any other type of ridden class. Mounts are eligible to compete in other classes. A snaffle bridle is to be used. The leading rein is to be fixed to the noseband. Reins are to go directly to the rider's hands. No string or any other aids fastened to the saddle to keep the pony's head in position are permitted. No spurs or whips. The handler may carry a cane. Riders should be able to rise to the trot. Clothing and equipment is to be similar to Hacking but judged as a Smartest on Parade. Both the handler and the rider are to be a current member of EA or Show Horse Council.

Bowthorpe Trophy: Open to all Thoroughbreds both Show & Hunter types, Registered with the Studbook Soc. of Australia. Proof of Registration, required with entry. Winner of this class is not eligible for champion Show Hack.

CHAMPIONS: All first place winners are eligible for the relevant Champion award within their section, unless otherwise stated in the class listings. The exhibit that is placed second to the selected Champion in its qualifying class is eligible for Reserve Champion.

“JIM HUGHES AND SON SUPREME CHAMPION RIDDEN EXHIBIT”

To be judged by both judges from all Champion Show Horses, Small Pony, Large Pony, Small Galloway, Large Galloway, Small Hack and Large Hack Exhibits.

All Champions must start in these classes or notify the Arena Office. In the event of a Champion not starting in this class, the Reserve is eligible to represent that section and compete for applicable Supreme Champion Exhibit.

EXHIBITORS: Please note that all manure and rubbish is to be removed from parking, stable and working areas. Scoopers and rubbish bins provided. Our future use of this space depends on your co-operation.
