- Entry fees:** As per program for each class (\$10 per height class, \$12 for Championship competitions)  
A \$40 levy applies to non SJT members

- Prizes :** Sashes or Ribbons will be awarded to 4<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> place, depending on the number of entries in the class  
A percentage of entry money will be paid out as prizes or prize money for all classes & as stated in schedule  
Horses may compete in a maximum of three (3) classes, including 1 (one) championship only.
- Dress Code:** As per Article 256, Current EA national Jumping Rules
- Rules :** Equestrian Australia National Jumping Rules – effective 1 January 2016



***Horses competing in classes 6,7, 8 & 9 must be registered with EA and hold a current performance licence and riders must be a competition member of EA/ET . For any Grading class- no prize money will be paid until EFA competition license is presented to judge.***

Table A:Art 238.2.2 This competition is run with one round not against the clock. If there are competitors with equal penalties after the first round then there may be one jump off against the clock to decide the placegetters . Other competitors are placed (if necessary) according to penalties and time incurred in the first round.

Table A : Article 238.2.1 In this competition competitors are placed in accordance with penalties and time incurred during the round . For competitors with equal penalties the competitor with the faster time is ranked higher. In the event of equality of penalties and time, there may be one jump-off against the clock for first place.

Article 273; This is a competition run over 2 rounds. The jumping penalties incurred over both rounds are added together. Riders will be placed according to the least number of penalties added over both rounds.

3.3; 4.3 – In this instance there is no jump off . Time in the second round may be used to decide placings after both rounds if there is equality of jumping penalties.
