Conditions of Entry, Rules and Regulations

Eligibility –

Classes 1, 2 3, - Competitors must be a member of Show Jumping Tasmania or Equestrian Australia/ Equestrian Tasmania. Horse registration with EA/Etas is not essential.

Classes 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8 – rider must be a current competitor member of EA/E Tas and horses must be registered with EA/E Tas and hold a current Competition Licence. Licences must be presented to the judge as requested & prior to the presentation of any prize or prize-money.

In addition, for all classes, non members of Show Jumping Tasmania will incur an additional entry fee of \$10 per class. For competitors wishing to join Show Jumping Tasmania, the membership details and forms required may be obtained from the secretary, Mrs Lisa Readett : ireadett@netspace.net.au

Competitions will be run under current Equestrian Australia Rules for Showjumping, 2nd edition (July 2015), & EA General Regulations 2nd Edition July 2015.

Riders are requested that provisions relating to the Equestrian Australia Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse & the Code of conduct for Warm-up Arenas and the EA Code of Conduct for Competitors are followed at all times. These policies may be viewed at

Dress Code: formal as per Article 256, 1.5

Close of entries – Thursday 3 December. Entries accepted on the day with \$20 late fee.

The committee reserve the right to amend the program in any way if necessary.

Horses may be entered in 3 classes.

Prizes, money and ribbons will be awarded to 4th or 6th place, dependent upon the number of starters in the class.

The banks may be used at the discretion of the course builder.
