REGULATIONS

This show is conducting all saddle classes as unofficial so horses and riders DO NOT NEED to be EA registered. Only some of the jumping classes are Official (see Official jumping section).

Penalties may be imposed on anyone found not observing these conditions.

- 1 **Membership** – of the society is \$25 per family. This entitles entry to the show ground for 2 adults, 2 children and a vehicle. Exhibitors who are not members will be charged at the gate for entry to the ground.
- 2 **Eligibility** – in the event of the judge or chief steward considering that any of the exhibits do not comply with the society's conditions, the same may be disqualified.
- 3 **Age** – to be taken as at 1 January 2015.
- 4 **Drugs** – EA rules regarding forbidden substances apply to all competitors and horses. Random drug tests may be conducted at the show.
- 5 **Protests** – Must be lodged in writing to the chief steward within one hour of the incident leading to the protest. They may only be lodged by an exhibitor in the same class as the one in which the protest was made. Each protest must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50, the deposit to be forfeited to the society should the protest be deemed frivolous. Any dispute as to the interpretation of the rules, by-laws, regulations or provisions shall be determined by the executive committee, whose decision shall be final.
- 6 **Liability** – The society will not be held responsible for any accident whatever caused to any exhibit, owner, rider or his/her property whatsoever. All entrants must sign the waiver form on the back of the entry form. Jumping is conducted under Equestrian Australia National Jumping Rules.
- 7 **Safety Regulations** – All riders shall wear approved protective headgear when mounted anywhere on the ground and dress as per Article 256.a. Exhibitors are responsible for their animal's wellbeing and horses must be safely secured while at the ground.
- 8 **Alterations** – The committee reserve the right to combine, delete, add or alter the programme, or order of the events, and to refuse any entry with or without giving the reason.
- 9 **Cash awards** – If less than 3 in a class 1st prize money only will be given. No prize will be awarded to an unworthy exhibit.
- 10 **Pre-show enquiries and scratchings** – Jumping enquiries to Leonie Blackwell (6362 2098), Saddle Class and General enquiries to Sandra Atkins (0429 946 554). **Scratchings** – to Ann Graves (6362 2009 or email).
- 11 The **Removal** of horse manure and feed is expected of all competitors

SHOW JUMPING

This show is affiliated with EA for the conduct of these jumping classes. To take part in graded events riders must be in their 12th year or older and members of EA. Horses must be registered and hold a current performance card. Prizes may not be paid for registered combination unless proof of registration can be provided when required.

Horses may not compete in more than 3 show jumping classes, including only one Championship.

Horses competing in Ring 1 may compete in Ring 2 providing they do not compete in more than three classes in total, however only one height class and one championship is allowed in ring 1.

For classes with 2 sections please state clearly on your entry form whether competing in part a) or b). These classes will be run concurrently, so combinations in part b) will need to be ready to ride directly after the last combination in part a) has completed their round.

Courses will be about the stated height for the first round. They may be enlarged for any subsequent rounds or jump-offs.

A Draw will be conducted for all classes. Riders are requested to present in the drawn order. The draws for both rings will be available from our web site www.deloraineshow.com.au on the Friday before the show. The Thursday before show day
