Regulations

Rider Eligibility: Competitors must be current financial members of SJT or Equestrian Tasmania.

** Equestrian Tas (or EA) members who are NOT members of Show Jumping tasmania may compete – BUT the entry fees will be as outlined below

Entry fees: Show Jumping Tasmania members - \$30 per horse, \$25 for second and subsequent horses.
Non SJT members : \$60 per horse

TEC Ground levy - \$5 per rider.

Horses may compete in a maximum of **two (2) events**

Prize money: as stipulated for each class.

Ribbons awarded to 4th or 6th place – this will depend on number of starters in each class.

Dress Code: Formal, i.e. *Jacket and tie. EA Art 256; 1.5.*

Rules : Classes conducted under current EA Jumping Rules (updated Jan 2015). Reference may be made to the FEI Memorandum for Show Jumping Events, 10th Edition and FEI Stewards Manual (July 2014)

Horses will jump strictly in drawn order

The organising committee reserves the right to combine, alter or cancel classes or the published prizes if necessary.

Competition Licenses must be presented before any prize money is presented in relevant classes.

Classes 3A, 4 & 5 are Open to EA Registered horses only. Rider must be Competitor member of EA & Show Jumping Tasmania.
National Jumping Points may be awarded for placegetters in these classes.

A derby is a special competition which takes place over a long distance of at least 1000m. The obstacles may comprise natural fences in addition to standard show jump obstacles and may include banks, ditches and water. A Derby is run with one round and one jump-off. Show Jumping South conduct our Derby Competition over slightly shorter distances and utilizing our banks as obstacles.
