Interschool Championships 2023

2023 Interschool Championships will be hosted by Equestrian Victoria in Werribee In Sept/Oct (dates to be announced).

In April 2023 ETAS in conjunction with the Sporting Committees will call for applications from Primary and Secondary Students to be considered for a place on the 2023 Tasmanian Team.

For those who attended in previous years, it has been a highlight of their year.

"It is fun to hang out with all my friends from other states"

"Highlight was being able to compete in another *2 event"

"Great to realise that riders in tassie are just as good as riders from larger states"

"Highlight was getting to know riders from other states and having the opportunity to compete at events with them"

Membership Requirements

To be considered for a place on the Tasmanian Team you need to obtain qualifying rides as a rider/horse combination in your chosen sport/s at the level you wish to complete or above.

To obtain qualifying rides the rider must hold the following at the time of the event:

- **ETAS Membership** participant or competitor depending on the level you are riding at, however, if selected for the National team a competitor membership is required
- **Interschool Licence** The Interschool licence is linked to the rider, and covers from the time of purchase until 30 June 2023. No event can be used as a qualifier without holding an Interschools Licence at the time of the event.

The Interschool licence can be purchased at the time of membership renewal/sign up, or via your MYEA Online portal under merchandise at a fee of \$38.50.

For certain competition levels, your horse will also require a **Full Horse Registration** and a **Sports Licence/s.** These can be obtained via your MYEA Online Portal

Please see our <u>membership flyer</u> to assess which membership level best suits you during qualification. Please note a full horse registration and competition licence/s is required for all horses and riders selected to compete at the National Championships.

Events in the 12 months prior to time of application can be used.

Discipline Qualifying Events and Requirements

The following sections detail the requirements, please note these are the **minimum requirements**, you are encouraged to record and submit all your results.



All Dressage Tasmania events have the option for you to select that you are riding Interschool allowing your ride to become a qualifier.

Required Results

The combination must score a **minimum of two tests** with a score of:

- Min 60% for preliminary and novice
- Min 58% for all other levels.





All Jumping Tasmania events can be used as a qualifier at your height, as long as you have an Interschool Licence at the time of the competition.

Result Requirements

The combination must have competed at a **minimum of 3 classes** at the nominated height with

- one result with no faults incurred
- two results with a maximum of 4 jumping penalties.





Utilising the above requirements for Dressage and Jumping, combinations must meet the requirements noted for both disciplines and can enter these as qualifiers.

In addition, Eventing Tasmania will hold combined training classes at the state champs.

- Northern Eventing Champs 26th March 2023
- Southern April Champs 15 16th April 2023
- NW to be announced









The combination requires 3 qualifying rides made up from the following

Three Eventing Champs Champs

- Northern Eventing Champs 26th March 2023
- Southern April Champs 15 16th April 2023
- NW (TBC)

OR

- One Eventing Champs (as above)
- One/two EA classes ODE's
- One PCT equivalent ODE grade can be used for ONE EA class above

Required Results

- Maximum 20 XC jumping penalties
- Less than 12 SJ penalties





All ETAS Show Horse events have the option for you to select that you are riding Interschool allowing you entry to become a qualifier.

Required Results

- Combinations must achieve points at official Show Horse events from 1st Place [10 points], second place [7 points], 3rd place [5 points].
- Champion will be 12 points and Reserve 10 points.

This is across all pony/galloway/hack sections and riding classes. Points will be calculated at the end of the season for team placement.

A Champion at the ETAS Horse of The Year event is an automatic qualifier for the Interschool Nationals.



Riders are encouraged to keep a record of **all their rides** noting %, placings, penalties/faults, event date and name as these will all be required at the time of application and will be checked.
