

Junior Rider Profile: Sarah Beltz and Blues Point **Christmas Mint**

Each newsletter, we will include a profile on one of our EA members, pay tribute to our up and coming riders, particularly our juniors who are the future of our sport.

Sarah's first competition was Brighton Show in November 2013 at age 11 where she won her junior rider class. In January this year, Sarah competed at the EA Tasmania Horse & Rider of the Year Championships 2014 held in Launceston, where she won Champion Junior Rider of the Year which qualified her to represent Tasmania at the upcoming Australasian Show Horse and Rider Championships. Sarah also qualified for Interschools and the Grand **Nationals** Championships. Sarah's family say that representing Tasmania at the Australasian Show Horse and Rider Championships in December will be an amazing life experience for Sarah and one that the family won't miss.

At the Launceston Royal Show in October this year, Sarah and Mint won the Childs Large Show Hunter Pony (Rider 17 years and Under), Owner Rider Large Show Hunter Pony and they also won Novice Intermediate Rider 12 Years and Under 17 Years. At the Hobart Royal show, Sarah was awarded Champion Rider under 11 Years.

At the Show Horse Council Horse of the Year, Mint was Runner Up in the Open Hunter Class and won overall for all saddle classes (rider under 17). Sarah was also runner up Junior Rider of the Year.

Friends agree that Sarah's values include being disciplined and always being a kind and considerate sportsperson. After only a year of competitive riding, this is a great achievement.
