The organising committee has the right to alter, omit or add to the advertised programme classes, conditions and prizes if conditions on the day so require.

#### **Eligibility**

To be eligible to be selected for the Australian Interschool Championships riders must be current financial members of Equestrian Australia (EA) and enter Division 1. Full Junior membership is required to enter all classes 1.05m and above. Equestrian Tasmania are offering discounted membership of \$69 for Junior or \$48 for Junior Recreational. Visit www.tas.equestrian.org.au for full details and to register. Non-EA members may only compete in Division 2 and will be ineligible for team selection and Champion prizes.

#### **Dress Code**

School jumper or rugby top, shirt, tie, approved safety helmet, jodhpurs and riding boots.

#### **Prizes**

#### Individual

The Champion and Reserve Champion in division 1 of each group will receive a sash.

Individuals will receive points for placings in each class. The first placed horses will get 40 points, second will get 39 points, third will get 38 points and so on to the last placed horse. The points received in each class are totalled to decide the Champion and Reserve Champion. In the event of a tie, the Champion will be the combination with the lowest penalties/fastest time in the Two Phase competition

Ribbons to 4th place will be awarded in each individual class for division 1 and division 2.

#### Team

A team shall consist of three horses and three riders that are full time students of that school (exception allowed for a school with only 2 riders competing – in this case their 2 scores added will constitute the team score). A rider may only compete in one team .The winning team is the one having the highest total score taken from their top 2 riders, the second is the one with the next highest total score taken from their top 2 riders, and so on. In case of equality of marks, the winning team is the one where the lowest level competitor has the best result. The winning School at each event will receive a Equestrian Tasmania Banner. Champion sashes will be awarded to the Champion team in division 1 of both Primary and Secondary sections.

#### Entry

Entry fee is \$35 per horse. Entries close 5pm, Friday June 17th, 2016. Entries will not be accepted after this time.

#### **Camping and Yards**

Camping and a limited number of yards are available for Saturday night. There is a toilet and shower on-site. Yards are \$5.00 on a first-in basis. Camping is \$5.00 per person. Please email Barb Cook for bookings.

Each horse/rider combination may compete in **ONE** group and division only. They must nominate in which group and division they will compete on the entry form. The heights and classes are as follows;

## Classes conducted under current EA National Jumping and Interschool Rules available from www.tas.equestrian.org.au

The Jumping competition for each group and division comprises three classes:

#### Article 238.2.2

This is a competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other athletes are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round.

#### Article 238.2.1

Athletes with equality of penalties for any place are placed in accordance with the time taken to complete the round. In the event of equality of penalties **and** time for first place, there may be a jump-off over a shortened course over obstacles, which may be increased in height and/or spread.

#### Two-Phase Article 274.5.3

This competition comprises two phases run without interruption, each at an identical or different speed, the finishing line for the first phase being identical with the starting line for the second phase.

The first phase is a course of 7 to 9 obstacles with or without combinations (Table A Against the clock). The second phase takes place over 4 to 6 obstacles, which may include one combination. (Table A Against the clock).

Athletes penalised in the first phase are halted by ringing the bell after they have jumped the last obstacle or when the time allowed for the first phase has been exceeded, after crossing the finishing line of the first phase. They must stop after crossing the first finishing line.

Placing is according to the penalties and time in the second phase and, if necessary, to the penalties and time in the first phase.

Athletes stopped after the first phase may only be placed after athletes who have taken part in both phases. In the event of equality for first place, the tied athletes will be placed equal first.
