All Pony Club entries must be approved by your Club District Commissioner prior to entry. Please check the box on the entry form. **Late entries may not be accepted!**

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Riders must be *bona fide* members of the club which they represent in all inter-club competitions. Both horse and rider need to be rally qualified.
- Pony Club Grade 4 riders must have fully completed one (1) qualifying ODE.
- All Pony Club riders must have their DC's approval to enter, and be capable of completing all phases of the ODE.
- TEA riders have no minimum qualifications.

AWARDS:

- **Individual placings** from 1st to 4th in each Pony Club grade will receive sash ribbons.
- TEA place getters will receive TEA ribbons.
- **1st place** in each grade will receive a trophy or saddle blanket.
- **Grades** are: Gr 4 senior, Gr 4 junior, Gr 5 senior, Gr 5 Junior (may be led), Training and Learners.
- **Best Presented** sash awarded.
- **Optimum Time** in Cross Country. An award will be presented for the rider with time closest to the Optimum Time.

- **Presentations** will be made 30 minutes after final results have been printed and posted.

LIABILITY: Neither Launceston Pony & Riding Club Inc., the organising committee, nor the PCAT, accepts liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground, spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever.

Medical & Veterinarian Services:

- Back protectors are strongly encouraged during the cross country phase, for all competitors and are compulsory for EA participants.
- A paramedic will be on site for the duration of the Cross Country and showjumping phases.
- A Veterinarian may not be on site. A list of local Veterinarians will be on display.

RESERVATION OF RIGHT: The organisers reserve the right to cancel any class or event; divide any class; alter the advertised starting times; and refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.

DRAW and RESULTS: The Draw, Programme and final results will be made available on the LPRC Website at www.launceston.pcat.org.au

RULES: This event is run under PCAT Rules for Pony Club Eventing (EFA plus PCAT Addendum). Refer to the link [PCAT Rules for Eventing](#), and [Dressage tests for 2014 Eventing season](#) .

- No rider who has taken part in a Grade 1 State Trials may compete in Grade 4, but may take part HC (Hors Concurs). You must note this on your entry form.
- Similarly, if you are riding down a grade, you must notify the entry secretary that you have to carry a penalty.
- All Pony Club riders' at all official events shall carry their current membership cards and present them for inspection when collecting their numbers.
- Medical Armbands worn on the upper left arm are compulsory and the information must be up to date. They will be examined when back numbers are collected, and by the XC gear checkers.
- A Grade 5 combination cannot have previously competed in a Grade 4 event.
- Riders may carry whips in the dressage phase.
- Riders may only be led in Grade 5 Junior.

PRESENTATION: All Pony Club riders must be plaited up when presenting for GEAR CHECK for the dressage phase.

MULTIPLE HORSES: A rider with more than one horse in the same class must state on the entry form the order in which she/he wishes to ride them or must abide by the draw. No classes will be held up to accommodate riders with two horses. No refunds will be given for riders who have not been able to participate in each phase.

DRESSAGE TESTS:

- Grade 4 will be EA Preliminary I.I
- Training (EVA65) will be EA Preliminary I.I
- Grade 5 will be PCAV 5B with canter
- Learners (EVA50) will be PCAV 5B with canter

- Grade 5 Junior - if led, will be PCAV 5A (No canter)

CANTEEN:

Full canteen will be available.

Fresh clean tap water is available from the south east corner of the arena and also near the club house car park.
