- Entry will be via the MAIN GATE.
- Please take home all your hay and manure, grass seed is available on the NTEC show jump trailer if your horse has dug up around your float.

TEA Entry – Open to all TEA (NTEC/STEA/NWEA members), membership forms are included.

Riders competing in EVA 80cm and above also require an EA membership.

Canteen – A canteen will be provided.

Toilets - are available to the eastern side of the horse arena.

Water – Bring your own water.

Warm up areas – Large warm up area for all phases located in the 'back car park' past the dog/SJ arena. Smaller area available alongside the dog/SJ arena for rider's next due to compete.

Dress – Competition dress and presentation preferred. Neat attire permitted for new members.

Ground pack up – Presentations will be held once the dressage arenas, XC course and show jump course have been packed away.

Camping & Yards – Overnight camping and yards will be available behind the sand dressage arena. No showers are available. Those wishing to camp must book in advance. Access will be via North Rd, and all campers must be onsite between 3 and 6pm, unless organised prior. All campers will be required to pay entry to Bull Ride.

Alternative camping is available at Westbury Showgrounds.
