Classes 7-9 Horses must be registered with EA – Tas & proof of registration supplied

Prizes: as stipulated for each class. Kindly supported by Saddleworld Cambridge Ribbons awarded to 6th place.

Dress Code: Formal, i.e. *Jacket and tie*. EA Art 256; 1.5.

Rules: Classes conducted under current EA Jumping Rules (updated July 2015). Reference may be made to the FEI Memorandum for Show Jumping Events, 10th Edition and FEI Stewards Manual (July 2014)

Horses will jump strictly in drawn order

The organising committee reserves the right to combine, alter or cancel classes or the published prizes if necessary.

Competition Licenses must be presented before any prize money is presented in relevant classes.

Horses may be entered in a maximum of 3 classes

EA NATIONAL JUMPING RULES

PLEASE TAKE SOME TIME TO LOOK AT THE RULE BOOK PRIOR TO COMPETITION

Article 238.2.1

Athletes with equality of penalties for any place are placed in accordance with the time taken to complete the round. In the event of equality of penalties and time for first place, there may be a jump-off over a shortened course over obstacles, which may be increased in height and/or spread in accordance with the provisions of the schedule.

Article 238.2.2

This is a competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other athletes are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round.

Article 273 , 2.2 , 3.2

This competition comprises, with the same speed, two courses, identical or different, either in track or in number of obstacles or in the dimensions of the obstacles.

Each athlete must participate with the same horse.

Athletes, who have been eliminated or who have retired during the first round, may not take part in the second round and may not be placed.

2. All the athletes have to take part in the first round. The following go forward to the second round according to the conditions of the schedule:

2.2 a limited number of athletes (at least 25% and in any case, even it is not mentioned in the schedule, all clear rounds) in accordance with their placing in the first round (penalties and time or penalties only, according to the conditions of the schedule)

3.2 First round and second round – not against the clock. One jump –off if required for first place
