Entry Conditions

1. Closing date of entries – **Sunday, 30th November, 2014**
2. Horses may only compete in two classes per day.
3. Entries MUST have all horse, rider and owner details.
4. All entries will be via www.nominate.com.au. Commentary sheet to be completed via Nominate. **No late entry accepted under any circumstance.**
5. All current FEI and EA Rules will apply to competitors and horses. All owners and riders must be current members of Equestrian Australia. Horses entered in graded classes must be registered and produce current competition licence.
6. The Organising committee reserves the right at its absolute discretion to alter or amend any part of the program.
7. The Organising committee reserves the right to ballot horses if necessary.
8. Protests are to be submitted in writing to the Organising committee within 15 minutes of an incident or announcement of placetakers, with a fee of \$50, to be refunded if protest upheld.
9. Substitution of a nominated horse may take place **ONLY** at the discretion of the Organising committee.
10. Scratchings: 75% of entry fee will be refunded **only** if Veterinary or Doctors Certificate is produced up to three days after the competition.
11. Swabbing will take place.
12. A ground fee of \$20 per competitor must be paid with entries and will cover swabbing, ground hire, camping and administration fees.
13. Yards will be available at \$10 per horse per day (maximum 2 days).
14. Juniors: Competitors may take part in competitions for juniors until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18. Young riders: competitors may take part in competitions for young riders from the beginning of the year they reach 16 until the end of the year they reach 21.
15. Horses may not compete in competitions for both Junior and Young Riders Championships.

- Horse to have Performance Licence (except for Classes 1 and 2A)
- Prize and cash for placegetters depending on entries
