**Stewarding Seminar for all disciplines**

Registration and coffee 9am to 10am,  
Morning tea and lunch are provided.

Presenter Chris Wallis will talk about the work of stewards at events so you can choose the discipline that you want to work in:

- to help create a level playing field for all athletes
- most importantly, to ensure that the welfare of the horse is respected

**COST:** \$50 for EA members, \$100 for non-members. Cost includes certificate of participation, EA steward vest upon completion of accreditation, two years registration and accreditation as an EA official and certificate of accreditation.

In addition to attending this seminar, in order to become accredited as an EA national steward, candidates also need to sit a short Open Rule Book Test (ORBT) and assist at three events. Depending on your previous experience you could be eligible for direct accreditation. Contact the event organisers for more information (details below)

Once you are accredited as an EA national steward you may then attend an FEI Level 1 steward course.
