



Tasmanian Eventing Squad Application for 2024 Eventing Squads

Please read the criteria for each squad carefully to ensure you are applying for the appropriate category.

Squad Categories and Selection Criteria

State Eventing Squad A

- High Performance Program funding will be applied when available.
- Compulsory attendance at 2 squad clinics during the year
- Senior Riders
Must have achieved one MER at 2* from 1 July 2022- December 2023
- Young Riders (under 21 January 1st, 2024)
Must have achieved one MER at 1* from 1 July 2022- December 2023

State Eventing Squad B

- High Performance Program funding will be applied when available.
- Compulsory attendance at 2 squad clinics during the year
- Senior Riders
Must have achieved one MER at 1* from 1 July 2022- December 2023
- Young Riders (under 21 January 1st, 2024)
Must have achieved one MER at 95cm from 1 July 2022- December 2023

Development Squad

- High Performance Program funding will be applied when available.
- Compulsory attendance at 2 squad clinics during the year
- Senior riders
Must have achieved one MER at 80/95cm from 1 July 2022-December 2023
- Young Riders
Must have achieved one MER at 80cm from 1 July 2022-December 2023

Foundation Squad

- **Riders training at 80cm they must be EA members.**



REQUIREMENTS FOR SQUAD MEMBERSHIP

- These requirements apply for the Tasmanian Eventing Squad and the Development Squad riders.
- Coaching clinics will be organised using EA accredited coaches and using the Competitive Edge program. Clinics are already arranged for January and February, and April with relevant coaches. Planning is also underway for further clinics dependent on availability.
- Some clinics may be predominantly show-jumping and cross country. Clinics will be held at different facilities in Tasmania.
- Squad riders are encouraged to attend as many clinics as possible.
- A minimum of two clinics must be attended by all squad riders, except the Foundation Squad.
- Participation in the off-horse (zoom) program is compulsory.
- Squad shirts will be available.
- Athletes must be financial members of Equestrian Tasmania throughout the season.
- Riders will be able to attend clinic with a substitute horse for a valid reason on request.
- It is the riders' responsibility to inform the Squad Coordinator in writing, if the squad horse is sold, retired or changes riders.
- Riders must conform to the EA Code of Conduct, Social Media Policy and Welfare of the Horse.

On acceptance into the squad riders will be required to pay \$50.00 to show their commitment to the squad. Three coaches have been confirmed:
