REGULATIONS FOR HORSE SECTION

- Every nomination or entry of a horse to compete at the Show shall be made on the express stipulation and condition that the use of the arena for any purpose whatsoever, shall be entirely at the risk of the owner or trainer of the horse or other person using the arena.
- Membership of the Westbury Agricultural Society Inc is compulsory for all competitors
- 3. This show is affiliated with Equestrian Australia. Saddle classes and Showjumping classes are conducted under EA rules. All horses competing in Official Jumping classes must be EA registered, hold a current performance licence and be ridden by EA members. Riding, Led and Hunter events do not come under EA jurisdiction.
- 4. EA Rule Once a horse has competed at a Hack/Saddle Horse or a Show Hunter at its first official competition in a calendar year it must remain as a Hack/Saddle Horse or a Show Hunter for that calendar year.
- Performance Licences for all registered horses MUST BE AVAILABLE
 FOR SCRUTINY at all times. The relevant Performance Licence may be
 scrutinised upon entry into the ring, before presentation of prizes, or at
 any other time.

- 6. All mounts in Saddle and Riding Classes to be mares or geldings.
 Definition of Novice: All horses (or in the case of Riding Classes, riders which have won any Open Saddle (Rider) Class competing singly at an Agricultural Show or official competition, with the exception of a consolation class are not considered to be novice. Competitors may win three Novice Classes before proceeding to Open Class.
- 7. **Protests:** A sub-committee elected by the general committee will deal with all complaints and protests. In events held under EA rules, the EA representative present on the day will adjudicate. *Protests must be made within an hour of the happening which gives rise to the protest. All protests are to be made in writing and given to the Secretary before 4.00pm on the day of the Show, with a deposit of \$20 as a guarantee of good faith, but which shall be returned if the protest is upheld.*
- The committee has the right to refuse any nomination without appeal.
 Due to the large programme the committee reserves the right to alter or delete any event.
- HORSE YARDS. A limited number of horse yards are available for Thursday, Friday and Saturday night at \$10 per horse and must be booked using the entry form. Horse yards must be CLEANED and vacated by 7am.
- 10. CAMPING: There will be no camping or yarding of horses overnight on the main arena. Camping will be permitted in the stable area. Removal of horse manure and feed is expected of all competitors and horses are not to be tied so that they are standing on the trotting track.



CONDITIONS FOR PARKING 2016

GENERAL PUBLIC main carpark is near the railway lines in the paddock adjacent to the Showgrounds in Marriott Street.

DISABLED PARKING is on the Trotting Track in front of show stalls and the Industrial Hall – enter through Marriott Street gate and drive onto the arena and follow the Trotting Track clockwise.

HORSE EXHIBITORS

Removal of horse manure, hay, feed etc is expected of all exhibitors.

Due to limited space, vehicles will be required to park close together with horses tied at the rear of horse floats and if possible on the one side of trucks. Exhibitors who cannot tie their horses at the rear of their float or who have horses that kick, should use the overflow parking area. Cars without horse floats are not to park on the arena – this takes up room for horses.

SHOWJUMPERS COMPETING IN RING 1 with horse floats carrying 3 or more horses, trucks or goosenecks wishing to park near Ring 1, must apply for a special gate pass on the entry form. Only exhibitors with an allocated gate pass will be allowed entry through the Marriott Street gate near the railway line.

DRAUGHT HORSE EXHIBITORS may enter the showground to unload but then remove their vehicles and park them outside the showground in Lyttleton Street.

ALL OTHER HORSE EXHIBITORS must enter through the northern gate off Lyttleton Street (near yards) and drive clockwise around the trotting track and then park under direction of Parking Attendants. Failure to comply with parking instructions may incur disqualification from exhibiting at the Show. Once all parking space on and around the arena is full, exhibitors will be directed to the over flow parking area in a paddock adjacent to the Showground, entering off Lyttleton Street. It is recommended that Hunt Club exhibitors arriving at the show later in the day, use the over flow parking area.

The landowner who kindly makes his paddock available, has requested that strictly NO HAY is to be fed in the overflow parking area and all MANURE to be removed.

When arriving at the Westbury Show, please stay calm, be considerate, read signage, be familiar with parking conditions and listen to and follow instructions. If you have any queries or concerns please speak politely to officials. We are all volunteers and many of us are exhibitors too. We want everyone to be safe and enjoy their experience at Westbury Show in 2016.
